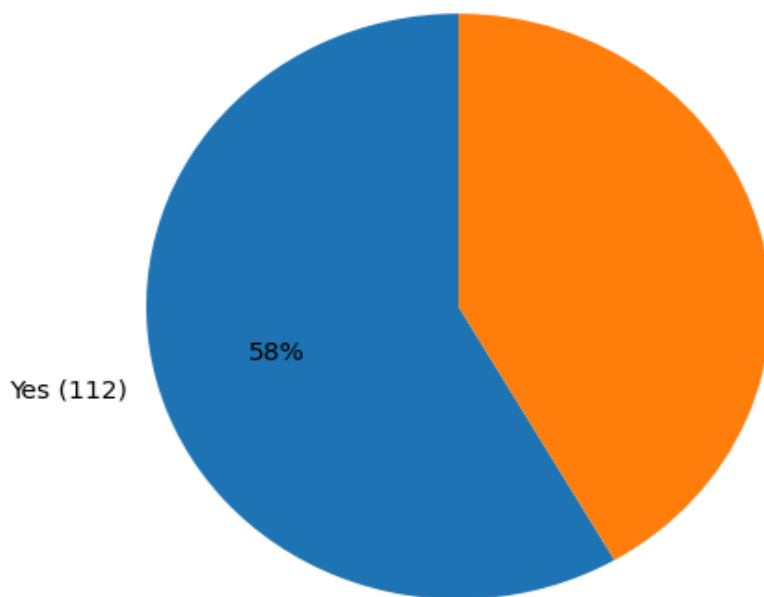


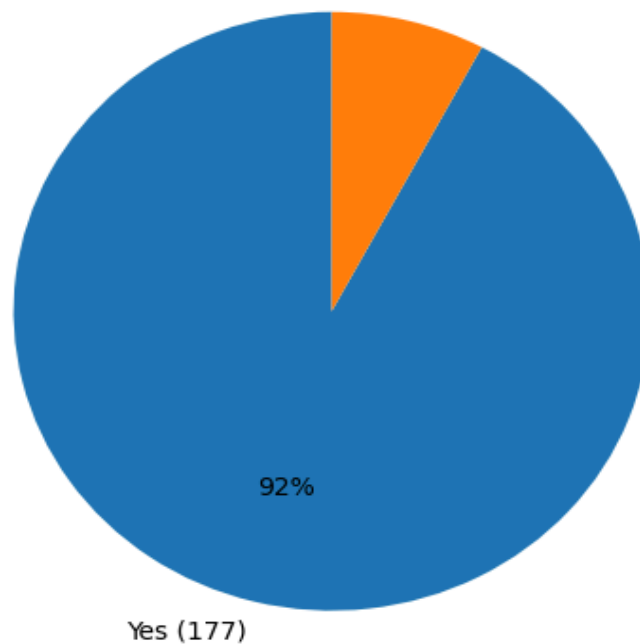
Survey Results and Data

For this book, a belongingness survey was conducted by the Amoris Christi Institute. The survey included 192 participants aged 15-24, representing four continents. Informed consent was obtained from all participants for the publication of the survey results. No personally identifiable information was collected, except for general demographic data, including age, gender, and place of residence.

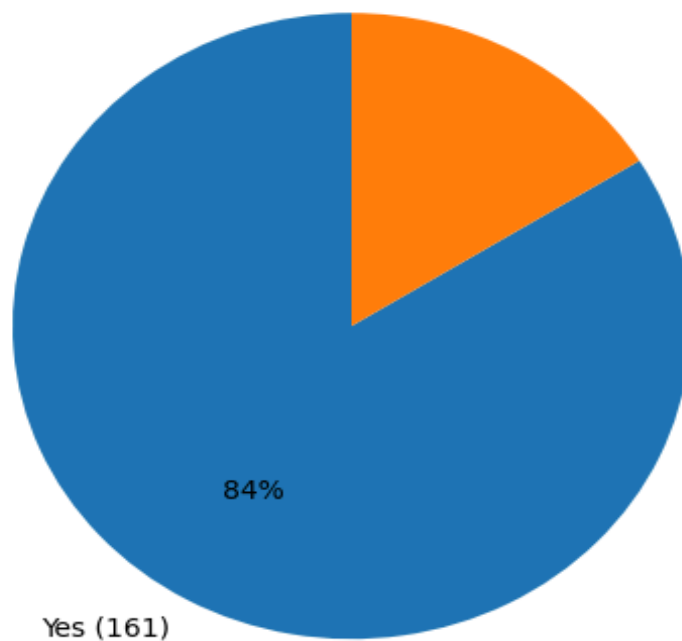
Do you experience feelings of isolation or loneliness due to a lack of belongingness? (n = 192)



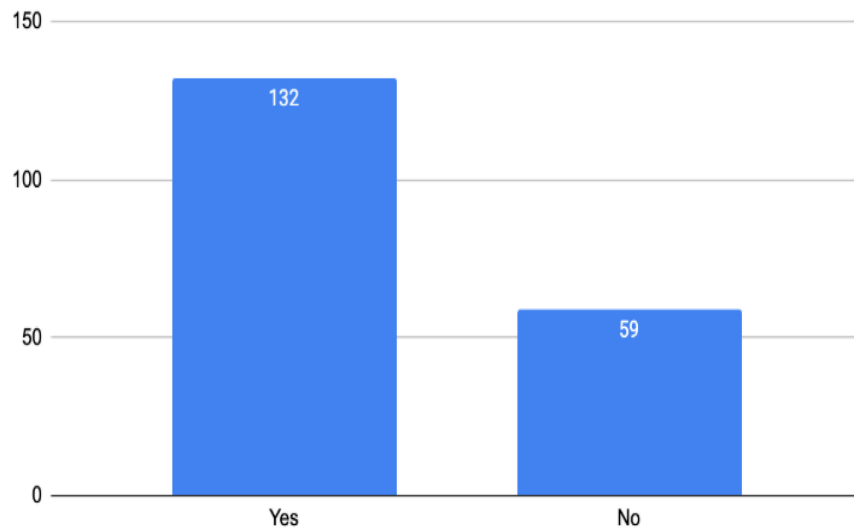
Do you believe you receive benefits from belonging to a community?

(n = 192)



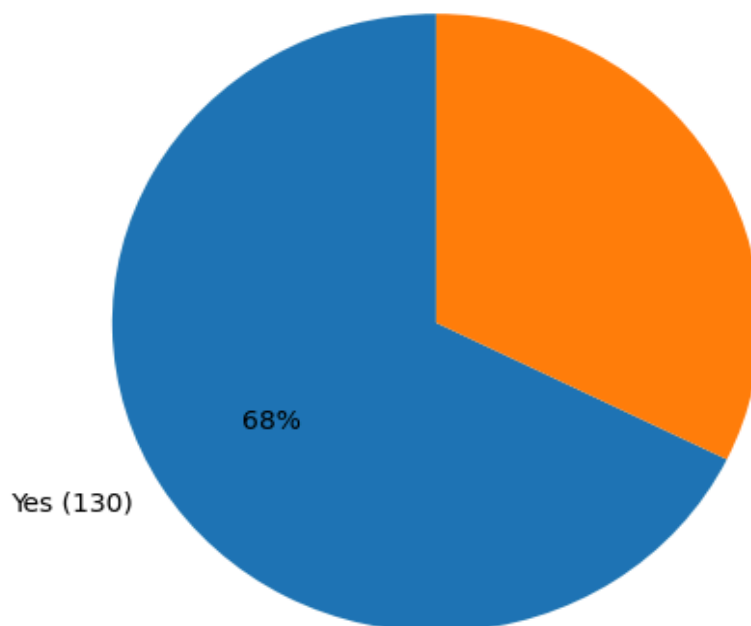
Do you feel a stronger sense of identity and purpose

(n = 192)



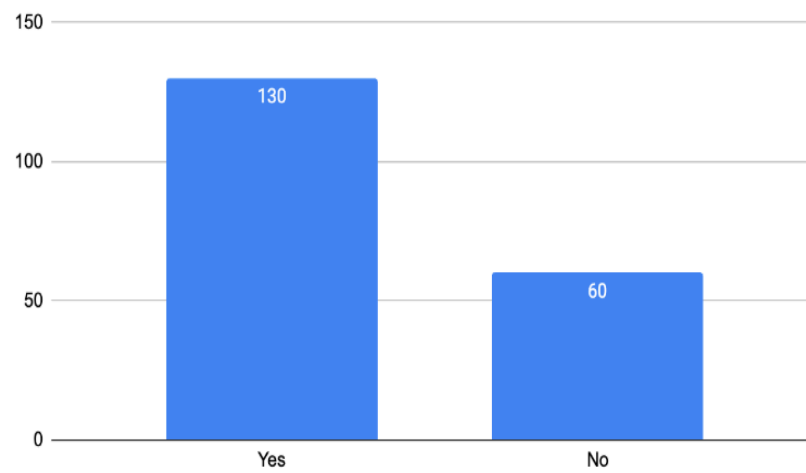
Do you attend/ participate in social activities or organized groups in person at least once a week? (This does not include obligatory attendance at church, classes, etc.)



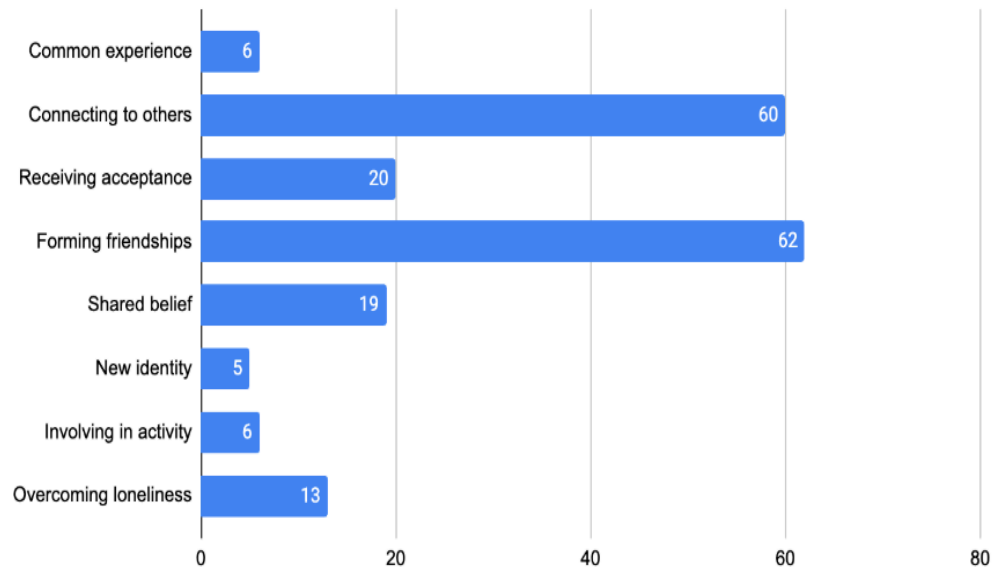
Have you ever refrained from participating in community activities due to social anxiety or shyness?
